What is the programme all about?

The Confederation Centre of the Arts Young Company is a summer training programme, coinciding with The Charlottetown Festival. We invite young people from diverse backgrounds to spend the summer on beautiful Prince Edward Island. The Young Company receives training that covers all aspects of life in performance-from voice to dance to acting to collective creation, all led by top theatre professionals. "YoCo", as it is affectionately known, also performs an original musical production, created during the rehearsal process. It is performed, free of charge, 6 days a week, in the Confederation Centre amphitheatre.

Programme Criteria:

All applicants must be between the ages of 18 & 30, and eligible to work in Canada. Additional requirements may apply.

Please submit, via email no later than January 12, 2020:

- 1) An APPLICATION VIDEO on an unlisted YouTube or Vimeo link
- 2) A headshot or recent photo of yourself
- 3) Resume or letter explaining your personal and work experience and how it is relevant to joining the Young Company.

Video Requirements:

- Introduction
- 1 or 2 Songs
- 1 Monologue/speech/poem

Introduction: Your video must begin with a short introduction of yourself. Tell us your name, where you are from, and a little bit about yourself, your hopes and dreams for yourself and Canada and finally, why you would

like to be a part of the Confederation Centre Young Company!

Song: Your songs (no more than 2) can be from a musical, pop music, rap, an original piece, a folk song, a traditional song or some combination thereof. They can be performed in your language of choice. If you would like to show 2 songs, make them contrasting styles to keep it interesting!

Monologue: your monologue (a short speech from a play, musical, movie, book or poem) in your language of choice - no more than 2 minutes.

Your video submission may also include a brief display of your dance skills and/or other unique performance talents (traditional dance, playing an instrument, gymnastics, speaking other languages), again, preferably in a wide-angle, head-to-toe frame and no more than 2 minutes.

Traditional songs, dances and speeches are welcomed and encouraged!

- We strongly encourage submissions from people of all backgrounds, cultures, genders, abilities and identities with varying degrees of experience.
- If you play a musical instrument, or speak languages other than English, please showcase this in your video!
