Project Description

We are looking for a Project Manager to provide support for an exciting virtual exhibition, "Exploring a National Treasure: L.M. Montgomery's Anne of Green Gables Manuscript." The project will make the original, handwritten manuscript of the novel that has captivated generations of readers, fans, and scholars, accessible digitally.

The Project Manager will provide support for the Director of Confederation Centre Art Gallery and a small team including a project Curator, Consultant, Web-Developer, and Steering Committee, through a five-phase project to plan, develop, evaluate, and launch a bilingual virtual exhibition. The virtual exhibition will contextualize the rare manuscript while providing users with multi-media interpretations, and commentary on the novel while highlighting the local and global reach of Anne. The project is a partnership between Confederation Centre Art Gallery and the L.M. Montgomery Institute and Robertson Library at UPEI made possible with an investment from the Virtual Museum of Canada program at the Canadian Museum of History.

Contract Details

Time & Duration Beginning in June 2020, the Contract will require part-time work over a

period of 27 months. The Project is expected to be completed by August

2022

Although the amount of time may vary from phase to phase of the

Contract, it is expected to require between 60 - 80 hours per month on

average.

The Project is based in Charlottetown, PEI at Confederation Centre of the Location

Arts. The Contract work is expected to be done, primarily, from the PM's

own work space/office (remotely).

Attendance in-person is expected for meetings with the Director, Team,

Vendors, etc. at the Centre.

Tools/Equipment As an Independent Contractor, the PM must provide their own

tools/equipment (including their own computer, PM software, email,

phone, etc.) and work space.

Meeting rooms are available for booking/use at the Centre for in-person

meetings with the Director, Team Members, Vendors, etc.
