What is the programme all about?

The TD Confederation Centre of the Arts Young Company is a summer training programme, coinciding with The Charlottetown Festival. We invite young people from across the country and from diverse backgrounds to spend the summer performing and learning. The Young Company receives training that covers all aspects of life in performance-from voice to dance to acting to collective creation, all led by top theatre professionals. "YoCo", as it is affectionately known, also performs an original production- *The Rising*. It is performed, free of charge, 6 days a week, in the Confederation Centre amphitheatre.

Programme Criteria:

All applicants must be between the ages of 18 & 30, Canadian citizens or permanent residents. Unfortunately, international students and those on work visas are not eligible. We strongly encourage submissions from people of all backgrounds, cultures, genders, abilities and identities with varying degrees of experience.

We strongly encourage submissions from people of all backgrounds, cultures, genders, abilities and identities with varying degrees of experience. At this time we are looking for BIPOC performers, especially Mi'kmaq/Indigenous.

Video Requirements:

Introduction: Your video **must** begin with a short introduction of yourself. Tell us your name, age, where you are from, and a little bit about yourself! (max 2 minutes)

Song: Show us 1 or 2 pop/rock songs (max 2 minutes each) that showcase your vocal strengths. They can be performed in your language of choice. If you perform 2 songs, please choose different styles to keep it interesting! Traditional songs, dances and stories are welcomed and encouraged!



Your video submission can also include a brief display of your dance skills and/or other unique performance talents (traditional dance, playing an instrument, gymnastics), preferably in a wide-angle, head-to-toe frame and <u>no more than 2 minutes</u>. We want to see you showcase your unique talents!
