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

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



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#### HISTORY OF THE MUSICAL

Anne of Green Gables–The Musical™ is the theatrical adaptation of the novel Anne of Green Gables by Lucy Maud Montgomery. Originally published in 1908, the novel radiates warmth and colour because Montgomery had a genius for perceiving—and re-creating—drama in everyday life.

Born one year after Prince Edward Island joined Confederation and 10 years after the historic Charlottetown Conference, Montgomery (1874-1942) grew up in communities that prized education, literature, and politics, and she was always consciously and proudly Canadian. Gifted with a highly visual imagination and an exceptional ability to evoke vivid imagery with words, she vowed at an early age to be a successful writer. She achieved international fame with her first novel. Anne of Green Gables, but wrote hundreds of stories and poems, including 18 other best-selling novels. In 1923, she was the first Canadian woman to be made a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts in Great Britain. Today, she is an iconic literary figure, not only in Canada, but the world.

Anne's story has touched the hearts of readers across the globe and the novel has sold more than 50 million copies. Young ladies in Japan, Polish soldiers in World War II, students in the Bronx, and scholars in Sweden have all been charmed by this impetuous orphan. The novel has been translated into more than 20 languages and adapted into many feature films and successful television series.

Since 1965, Anne of Green Gables–The Musical<sup>™</sup> has been delighting audiences at The Charlottetown Festival. Creators Norman and Elaine Campbell, Don Harron, and Mavor Moore have crafted a magical experience of Anne's mischievous energy, the humour and angst present in her every-day trials and tribulations, and above all, the power of human emotion that Montgomery delivered beautifully in her touching tale of a red-haired orphan.

This well-loved show has played internationally in London's West End, New York, Japan, and Sweden, and has toured to countless cities. *Anne of Green Gables–The Musical*™ won the prestigious 'Best Musical' award by the London Critics.

Each production takes on flavours of the locality and era, but the core story of Anne Shirley's adventures is universal and timeless. Anne represents the outsider in all of us; she stands out in a crowd, she's a sore thumb, a thorn in your side, a black sheep. This 2022 interpretation of Avonlea, back on its original stage after a COVID-forced hiatus, represents P.E.I. today. It is a diverse, tight-knit community, strong in its various traditions and heritage.

#### CHOREOGRAPHER'S NOTES

When I was first approached by the Festival to choreograph *Anne of Green Gables—The Musical*™, my reaction was, "Would I be able to do my own unique version?" I had started at the Festival in 2004; dancing Alan Lund's brilliant original choreography for the show under the direction of Anne Allan, and then danced and assisted with Mike Jackson's equally brilliant choreography under the direction of Marcia Kash. I have been involved in the Festival every year since.

I was concerned that being so closely tied to the show would make it difficult to find my own voice, so I spent a couple of days brainstorming ideas, making sure I was clear on the story I was trying to tell through the movement and, most of all, taking a cue from Anne herself: be as excited about the prospect of bringing those imaginings to life.

I think that the final result is much like the history of the Festival itself; learning from the giants that came before us and being inspired by that genius.

I decided to put subtle nods to Alan Lund's original ballet focused choreography in each number. For example, in "School Again" taking a section of Alan Lund's hopscotch but now doing it while skipping. Also, making my own variation of the climactic egg-and-spoon race.

Another important aspect to me was adding some more Island flavour into the choreography. How would the townsfolk move? What steps would the kids know to use in the concert? And what is more Island than a good old kitchen party, some fiddle, and step dancing?

The other thing I wanted to focus on was the growth of the young adults throughout the show. When we first see them bounding out in "School Again" we see the athletic, almost frenetic energy of kids going to school. I wanted to develop their personal relationships throughout the numbers so we see them progress. By the time we start Act II, the movement becomes more focused, we see the boys and girls trying to impress one another, taking a step towards maturity; also showing the equal strength and tenacity of the younger ladies in the play.

I am so deeply honoured to be a part of this festival and this show, and to be trusted to put my stamp on this legacy. This is now my 17th season and each year it feels like coming home. The message of the show has carried me through my life; imagination can change the world.

I hope you enjoy the choreography as much as I enjoyed creating it.
