# Performing Arts Camp Instructor

Performing Arts Camps play a vital role in introducing campers to a variety of artistic disciplines. Instructors are responsible for delivering safe, fun, and educational experiences for our campers. Instructors lead Performing Arts Camps for children ages 4-17 from July 11 - August 28, 2023.

### Duties of the Performing Arts Camp Instructor will include, but are not limited to:

- Supervising campers while in the care of Confederation Centre of the Arts
- Delivering fun and engaging lessons in various mediums of Performing Arts including, but not limited to: drama, dance, music (instrumental and/or voice)
- Teaching numerous classes to camp participants
- Coordinate and collaborate with other instructors
- Ensuring any Covid-19 protocols are upheld by campers
- On-going communications with parents, students, fellow teachers, and administrators
- Assist with program preparation and wind-up
- Studio organization
- other duties as required

### The ideal candidate will have:

- Proficiency with Windows and Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Outlook)
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills; English essential
- Positive attitude, patient, empathetic
- Detail oriented
- Ability to work independently with little or no supervision and prioritize efficiently
- Previous experience working with or supervising children

- Must have, or be willing to get a vulnerable sector check
