

dance umbrella 2023-24 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Classes begin <u>Saturday, September 9</u> and are held at the Mawson Rehearsal Hall and Studio 2 in the Confederation Centre of the Arts, and the Mack Studio at the Mackenzie Theatre.

REGISTRATION

<u>TO REGISTER</u>: *email* the registration form to <u>dance@confederationcentre.</u>com, *mail* to the address on the registration form (attention Callista Gilks) or leave it in the *drop-box* at the Richmond Street entrance of Confederation Centre. *Registration will not be guaranteed until payment has been received (in full, or with post-dated cheques or credit card authorization.)*

<u>SEMESTERS</u>: Our season runs in two semesters from September to December (Fall), and January to May (Winter). When you register for classes in September it is assumed you'll be with us until May, unless otherwise stated. Prices outlined below reflect tuition for both semesters.

FALL DEADLINE: Registration for fall semester is open until October 6, 2023. New students will be accepted after this date on a case-by-case basis. Late registrations will not be pro-rated until after October 6, 2023.

WINTER DEADLINE: Winter semester is open for new students until January 22, 2024.

FEE STRUCTURE

*Multiclass discounts apply to students or members of the same household taking more than one class per week. Students/households taking more than 3 classes per week should add \$280.00 per additional class (\$70.00 per payment)

**To use the payment plan, a NON-REFUNDABLE administration fee of \$10.00 is included in the first payment. Payment is due on or before the dates listed above.

***Musical Theatre is not applicable for multiclass discounts

ADDITIONAL FEES

<u>COSTUME FEE</u>: There is a NON-REFUNDABLE \$20.00 costume fee <u>per child/student</u> which aids in costume purchases and maintenance. Costume fee is in addition to the total due above and applied to the first payment if using payment plan (i.e. 2 classes per week, first payment will be \$220.00 which includes costume and payment plan fee). Costume fee does not apply to My Parent & Me, Creative Movement I, Dance for Health and Pre-Pointe classes.

<u>SHOW TICKETS</u>: Parent/guardian's will need to purchase tickets through box office to see Nutcracker, year-end showcase, and musical theatre show.

WORKSHOPS: Our workshop series is offered to dance umbrella students at a rate of \$5.00 per workshop.

PAYMENT DETAILS

METHOD OF PAYMENT: Cash, cheque, Visa, Mastercard, or American Express.

- For the payment plan, post-dated cheques or credit card authorization must be included with registration, or alternate arrangements made with our office. Cheques must be dated as outlined in the table above and are payable to <u>Confederation Centre of the Arts</u>.
- Unfortunately, we do not accept e-transfer for dance registration payments.

LATE OR INSUFFICIANT PAYMENTS:

- If payment is not up to date, the student cannot participate in class and may accrue interest of \$5.00 per week to overdue payments.
- A \$25.00 service fee will be charged for cheques returned by your financial institution.

<u>REFUNDS</u>: Refunds are available <u>up to October 6, 2023</u>, or if justified by a medical situation (a doctor's letter will be required.)

- The amount refunded will be equal to the amount paid minus the number of classes taken at \$15.00 per class.
- New students joining the winter semester may receive a refund after no more than two trial classes.

<u>WITHDRAWAL</u>: If a student chooses not to continue for the winter semester, written notice by email must be given to the Education Coordinator by <u>December 22, 2023</u>, and the third and fourth payments will not be processed.

- It is the responsibility of the parent/participant to notify the office; otherwise, payments will be processed.

ADDITIONAL TERMS

<u>CLASS CHANGES</u>: *dance umbrella* reserved the right to close/open/amend classes depending on the number of registered dancers. Families will be notified of any changes.

<u>CLASS CANCELLATIONS</u>: *dance umbrella* reserves the right to cancel classes due to weather conditions or instructor's illness. Classes cancelled due to inclined weather <u>will not</u> be rescheduled or refunded. Every effort will be made to run classes with a substitute in case of instructor illness, in the event the class is cancelled it will be rescheduled.

<u>CLASS PLACEMENT</u>: Students taking dance classes should feel confident, successful, and challenged. Students will be evaluated in class and may be moved to a different class to better match their skill level at the discretion of their instructor. Age, maturity, dance experience, and level of ability will be considered. Returning students will be notified with their class recommendations. New students should contact our office to receive a starting class recommendation.

⁵ Workshop Series is an educational series offering workshops to enhance students' health and dance training. A workshop schedule will be released each term, with a drop-in rate of \$5.00 for our students, \$10.00 to members of the community.

⁶ Hip Hop for Boys is a class designed to create a safe space for boys interested in starting dance aged 8 – 13 years.

⁷ Registering for Musical Theatre classes requires taking the Drama and Dance portions, this is included in the registration prices.

PERFORMANCE GROUP

Performance Group is an audition-based program for dedicated students who wish to develop their artistry and expand their performance opportunities. This is a non-competitive group and there is no charge to participate. Students learn repertoire throughout the year which may be performed at various opportunities in their communities, participate in workshops with visiting artists, and experience a taste of what it is to be part of a dance company. We are excited to announce that this year's performance group will be performing in our Nutcracker performance on December 2.

Please note that in addition to performance opportunities, students will participate in fundraising campaigns for their events and activities, there may be some additional costs for events not covered by fundraising/sponsorship which will be communicated as our fundraising goals are met.

Students must be age 12+ to audition and taking at least one technique class (ballet, contemporary, or jazz).

YEAR-END SHOWCASE

To conclude a wonderful dance season, we finish with our annual year-end showcase performance on Saturday, May 4. Rehearsals take place Tuesday, April 30 – Friday, May 3 from 4:00 – 8:00pm. A full rehearsal schedule will be released in January. Please note that Creative Movement I (3-year-old class) will have an in-studio presentation on Saturday, April 27 in lieu of participating in the on-stage performance.

<u>Acro</u>

We are excited to announce the expansion of our Acro dance offerings. Acro offers strength and flexibility training while students learn acrobatic tricks, enhancing their abilities in their technique classes. Junior Acro is for ages 9-12, and Senior Acro for ages 13+. Please note that students must take a technique class in either jazz, contemporary, or ballet to be eligible for Acro dance.

NEW! Hip Hop for Boys

Hip Hop of Boys is a class designed to create a safe and engaging space for boys interested in learning dance! This class focuses on breaking down the barriers to movement for boys by introducing students to Hip Hop styles in a supported environment. Lead by instructor Joe Dames, Hip Hop for Boys is for ages 8-13.

Inclusive Dance

Inclusive Dance is a safe and welcoming space for dancers who may need additional accommodations due to cognitive, physical, or affective disabilities. This program allows students to explore dance and movement patterns at their own pace, while allowing their creativity to soar under the guidance of our trained educators and educational assistants. The Junior level is for ages 9-12 and the Senior level is for ages 13+ Inspired by the Boston Ballet's Adaptive Dance Program, Inclusive Dance is breaking down barriers to make dance accessible to students with disabilities.

My Parent & Me

Do you have a toddler who can't stop dancing, but you're not sure if they're ready to attend a class by themselves? My Parent & Me welcomes children ages 18 months to 3 years and their parents to come explore dance together through songs, games, and stories. This is a great precursor to our Creative Movement program.

Workshop Series

The Workshop Series offers training and education in supplementary dance topics ranging from nutrition, post-secondary advisement in the arts, choreography and more. A schedule will be released at the beginning of each term, the workshop series is a drop-in class at a cost of \$5.00 for dance umbrella students and \$10.00 for the island community.
